The school counselor works to collaborate with school staff, families, and the community to meet the unique needs of each student.



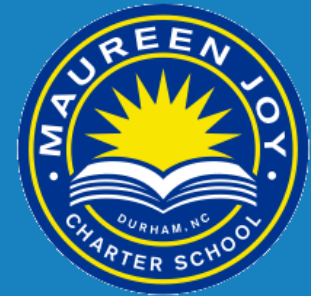
